Senior Club to Conduct Survey this Summer. Your input will help determine future Programs!

If all goes according to plan, beginning July 8th, 2009, the Brentwood Senior Citizens Club Inc., will conduct an extensive survey over the following several weeks of both Senior Club Members and Non-Members to find out what the interests and needs are of the area's Senior Citizens.

"We often think we know what our fellow seniors are interested in, or what their needs are, but our group is so diverse that we really aren't sure we're getting a good feel for what people want", said Dottie Bangs, Program Committee and Chair spearheading this summers survey project.

"With the completion of the Brentwood Senior Activity Center, we really want to make sure we're heading in the right direction" Bangs said. "And besides, what better time to really determine the direction of the Brentwood Senior Club than with a formal survey!"

So from July 8 through July 12, the Brentwood Senior Club will be directly contacting Club Members, soliciting their

input and will follow up with one on one surveys of non club members, and conducting community round tables from July 20th through July 31st.

Then beginning in August, the Program Committee will tabulate the survey results and present their findings to the Brentwood Senior Board of Directors at their September 1st meeting.

"This is an exciting time and we have a tremendous opportunity to really develop and expand our programs, activities, and services to meet the vast needs and interest of our senior community" said Bangs.

"We hope everyone shares their thoughts with our survey committee so we can really set a course of action for the coming year".

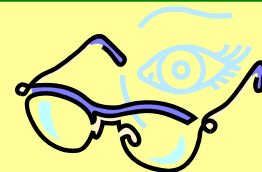

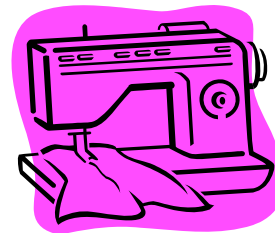

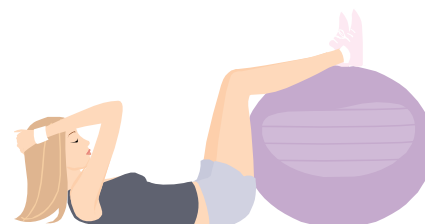

Brentwood Masters Swim

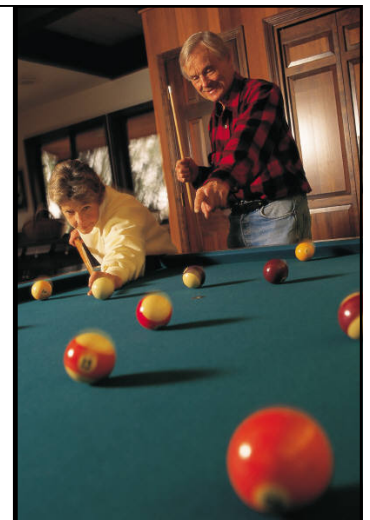

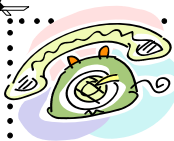

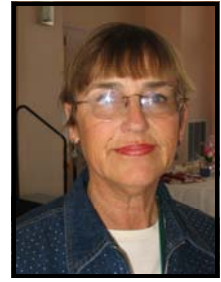


“Rides for Seniors Program”

It's Going to Get Worse!

That's right. The State budget crisis is only going to get worse on many levels, but in particular for two of our most vulnerable populations...the elderly and children. You have read about the proposed cuts to programs affecting both of these population sectors, so you can see how serious these impacts will be. Activists around our county and the state have mobilized efforts to contact the Budget Conference Committee in Sacramento to tell them NO to these cuts. Both the Chronicle and the Times on June 8th highlighted the impact these cuts would have on the Adult Day Health Care program, the Alzheimer's Day Care Resource Center and the Multipurpose Senior Services Program which would be eliminated altogether. The latter, for example, would affect over 12,500 frail seniors around the state.

Just about half of these, or 6,250 would immediately be placed in skilled nursing facilities at an annual cost of \$30,000 to Medi-Cal. It is estimated that the state would see about \$200 million in costs the first year MSSP is eliminated. I encourage you to keep your eye on what happens in Sacramento around all programs affecting our aging population. As we all know, issues affecting us are not going to go away anytime soon, so we better prepare ourselves for their impact.

Life is like an ever-shifting kaleidoscope - a slight change, and all patterns alter.

“The Oldies but Goodies Program”

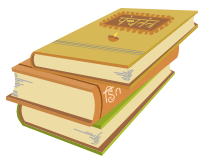

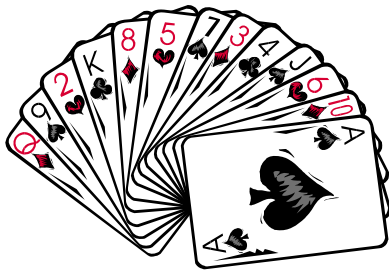
