Recently many of you may have heard that the Brentwood Community Center is slated to be replaced in the near future with a new civic center, and that a replacement community center is to be build to replace the current facility and will be located on city property located at Griffith and Balfour. (next to the Aquatic Center) To help keep everyone properly informed, the following excerpt is reprinted from the Brentwood Press and hopefully will clarify the current plan of action by the City of Brentwood.

City officials want to clear up any confusion there might be about the future of the community Center as it relates to the new Civic Center construction. Current plans are to build an 8,300 square-foot recreation center adjacent to the Aquatic Complex on Balfour Road. That facility, for which the city council approved \$50,000 in design fees at its January 27th meeting, will be twice the size of the current Community Center, and will house the recreational programs and activities presently conducted at the current Center.
